It is the resident's responsibility to license their dog. Licenses are due January 1st of each year.

There is a \$5.00 late fee after April 1.

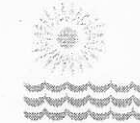


in the Town is provided by the Chippewa County Sheriff's Dept. **Emergency requests for sheriff and fire - CALL 911**

BURNING BARREL PERMITS ARE REQUIRED and available at the Town Hall during business hours. Call the office to update on a yearly basis. The Town does have an ordinance which details allowable items. **Burn dry paper and untreated wood only.** Prohibited by law is the burning of plastic materials, kitchen waste, dirty/wet paper, treated/painted wood, furniture and demolition material **NO OPEN BURNING ON SUNDAYS` OR HOLIDAYS`**

SNOWPLOWING: PLEASE PLACE GARBAGE CANS IN YOUR DRIVEWAY AND OFF OF THE TOWN ROADWAY SO IT IS NOT HIT BY THE PLOW. Make sure your mail box post is in good condition. The post and box must be able to withstand snow hitting them as it rolls off the plow blade. If the box is damaged due to poor condition or snow hitting it, the Town will not replace it. The box will be replaced only when the plow actually hits the mail box. Please be sure to shovel around your box to assure mail service.
